## Directed Studies/High Impact Experience/Research/Internship

The University catalog describes Directed Studies/High Impact Experience/Research/Internship courses as follows:

Directed Studies (285 or 485; 0 to 4 credits; ALEC 485 Zero credit only): Studies related to classroom, laboratory, supervised activities in agriculture, work experience, extension education and adult educational activities in agricultural programs. Required: Approval of instructor of record and Associate Head.

High Impact Experience (ALEC 399; Zero credit only): Participation in an approved high-impact learning practice; documentation and self-assessment of learning experience. Required: Approval of instructor of record and Associate Head.

Research (491; 1 to 4 credits): Initiation and completion of research under the direction of a faculty member in the student's degree area. Required: Approval of instructor of record and Associate Head.

Internship (494; 1 to 4 credits): Supervised internship and independent study related to student's professional interest. Required: Approval of instructor of record and Associate Head.

## It is further understood that:

- 1) Individual consultation and agreement between the student and faculty member of the Directed Studies/High Impact Experience/Research/Internship about the nature and conduct of such a course will precede the student's registering Directed Studies/High Impact Experience/Research/Internship.
- 2) The final, written report or product submitted by the student will be graded by the Instructor of Record of the Directed Studies/High Impact Experience/Research/Internship course and a copy filed in the department.
- 3) Although clock hours are not absolute or limiting, a general guideline is to work approximately 15 clock hours for each semester hour of credit being sought for a Directed Studies/High Impact Experience/Research/Internship course.
- 4) Deviations from the above conditions require approval of the Department Curriculum Committee. Prepare three copies one for each:
  - Faculty member directing the Directed Studies/High Impact Experience/Research/Internship
  - Student's record file
  - Student
